Dr. Nixon the author of three books: *The Year of the Locust* and *Venom in My Veins* and *Leading the Comeback Church*. Dr. Nixon has been a retreat speaker for pastors and spouses and seminar leader of pastors' *Skill Schools* and Pastors' Learning Days. In 2004, led workshops for *WordAction* on Evangelism through the Sunday School in nine *PALCONS* at our Regional Universities. He is also involved in training pastors internationally and most recently, provided training for pastors in the Africa region.
